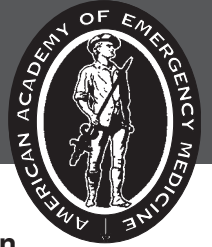

## AAEM/RSA Vision Statement

AAEM/RSA supports emergency medicine residents/fellows and students on issues pertaining to their education, practice environment, career development and personal wellness.

## AAEM/RSA Mission Statement

AAEM/RSA is a democratic organization committed to the following principles:

- Every individual should have unencumbered access to quality emergency care provided by a specialist in emergency medicine.
- The practice of emergency medicine is best conducted by a specialist in emergency medicine.
- A specialist in emergency medicine is a physician who has achieved, through personal dedication and sacrifice, certification by either the American Board of Emergency Medicine (ABEM) or the American Osteopathic Board of Emergency Medicine (AOBEM).
- The personal and professional welfare of the individual specialist in emergency medicine is a primary concern to AAEM/RSA.
- AAEM/RSA supports fair and equitable practice environments necessary to allow the specialist in emergency medicine to deliver the highest quality of patient care. Such an environment includes provisions for due process and the absence of restrictive covenants.
- AAEM/RSA supports residency programs and graduate medical education, which are essential to the continued enrichment of emergency medicine, and to ensure a high quality of care for patients.
- AAEM/RSA is committed to providing affordable high quality continuing medical education in emergency medicine for its members.
- AAEM/RSA supports the establishment and recognition of emergency medicine internationally as an independent specialty and is committed to its role in the advancement of emergency medicine worldwide.

## Resident/Fellow Membership

Resident/fellow membership is available for physicians enrolled in an accredited ACGME or AOA emergency medicine residency training program in the United States or the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada. Resident/fellow members elect the AAEM/RSA board of directors. The president of AAEM/RSA serves on the AAEM board of directors.

## International Resident/Fellow Membership

International member status is available for those residents/fellows who pursue an interest in emergency medicine who practice outside of the United States or Canada. Canadian residents/fellows who do not meet the above criteria and U.S. citizens who pursue an interest in emergency medicine in training programs that do not meet the above criteria are also eligible for international membership.

## Student Membership

Student membership is available for medical students at a LCME accredited medical program or an osteopathic program accredited by AOA's COCA in U.S. or Canada.

## International Student Membership

International member status is available for those medical students who pursue an interest in emergency medicine outside of the United States or Canada. Canadian students who do not meet the above criteria are also eligible for international membership. U.S. citizens who pursue an interest in emergency medicine in medical schools that do not meet the above criteria are also eligible for international membership.
