

TIERED GRANT FUNDING FOR AAEM/RSA-SPONSORED STUDENT-PLANNED EVENTS

Requirements pertaining to all levels:

- Students will apply for the grant with a minimum of 2 months of the date of the Symposium
- Students will agree at the time of application submission that they will meet the requirements for the given level of grant for which they apply. If requirements are not met, the grant funding can be rescinded.
- The primary student contact for the application submission will be an AAEM/RSA member.
- Up to 10 students volunteering the day of the symposium may have their registration fee waived, but will at least sign up for free student memberships if they have not already used their 1 year trial membership.

Platinum (for student symposia): \$501-1000

- Granted to only 1 program per year, can be the same program year after year but they will apply each time for it and be approved. This grant should be reserved for Symposiums aiming to achieve a minimum registration number of 120 students.

Requirements:

- All speakers for the event should be members of AAEM
- AAEM/RSA will be listed as the primary sponsor for the event and will be included in the event title
- AAEM/RSA's name will be listed on all promotional materials for the Symposium
- At least one 30-minute time slot will be reserved for a talk on the topic of AAEM and RSA by a current AAEM or AAEM/RSA board member. If an AAEM speaker is selected, then the AAEM President is given right of first refusal in consultation with the AAEM/RSA President and the EMIG coordinator.
- All student participants will either be existing AAEM/RSA members, or become members through the Symposium registration.
- Registration will be coordinated through the AAEM/RSA website.
- AAEM/RSA will be provided a table or booth at the event.

Gold (for student symposia): \$201-500

Requirements:

- AAEM/RSA will be listed as the primary sponsor for the event and will be included in the event title
- AAEM/RSA's name will be listed on all promotional materials for the Symposium
- At least one 30-minute time slot will be reserved for a talk on the topic of AAEM and RSA by a current AAEM or AAEM/RSA board member. If an AAEM speaker is selected, then the AAEM President is given right of first refusal in consultation with the AAEM/RSA President and the EMIG coordinator.
- All student participants will either be existing AAEM/RSA members, or become members through the Symposium registration.
- Registration will be coordinated through the AAEM/RSA website.
- AAEM/RSA will be provided a table or booth at the event.

Silver (for student symposia): \$101-200

Requirements:

- AAEM/RSA will be clearly acknowledged as a sponsor somewhere in the event agenda/program
- AAEM/RSA will be provided a table or booth at the event.
- Membership is not required of event registrants, but there will be an opportunity to sign up for free and paid student membership on site

Meet 'n Greet (1-2 hour event): \$50-100

Requirements:

- AAEM/RSA will be included in the event title.
- At least one 30-minute time slot will be reserved for a talk on the topic of AAEM and RSA by a current AAEM or AAEM/RSA board member. If an AAEM speaker is selected, then the AAEM President is given right of first refusal in consultation with the AAEM/RSA President and the EMIG coordinator.
- AAEM/RSA will be provided a table or booth at the event.
- Membership is not required of event registrants, but there will be an opportunity to sign up for free and paid student membership on site
